

### How-to guide: toilet roll pyramid

## Why this toy is great for cats:

Cats are natural hunters.
They're born with the drive
to stalk, chase and pounce.
When a cat first enters a new
environment, they usually
prioritise feeling safe over play.
But when settled in, hunting-like
activities are a great way to bring
out their playful side and let
them unwind.

Interactive puzzle feeders like this pyramid help keep your cat mentally engaged, providing a fun challenge and an outlet for their natural behaviours.

#### **Materials**

- 21 toilet roll tubes (or adjust for a larger/smaller pyramid)
- A piece of cardboard for the base (approx. 45cm x 35cm)
- Scissors
- Tape

## **Difficulty level:** Easy

**Time to make:** 15 to 20 minutes

#### Instructions



**Step 1**Gather a minimum of six toilet roll tubes



**Step 2**Grab your Sellotape



**Step 3**Start sellotaping the cardboard rolls together

### Tip for play:

Change toys regularly to keep things fresh for your cat. When using puzzle feeders, make sure to count any treats or biscuits as part of their daily diet to keep them at a healthy weight.

Step 4

Make sure you stick them together at the front and back



Step 5

Build them into a pyramid shape as you're fastening



Step 6

Introduce the pyramid to your cat with a few treats or biscuits hidden in the tubes and let the play begin!
